

Wallet Mini Album 8" x 6"

Designed by Rebeca Ruiz for My Creative Scrapbook



Materials:

- 9 sheets of cardstock in any coordinating color, it can be 8 ½" x 11" or 12" x 12"
- [My Creative Scrapbook](#) December 2021 kit
- Paper trimmer
- Scoring Board
- Double sided tape
- Bone folder
- Ribbon (approximately 32") or preferred closure method (Ex. magnets, Velcro, band, or other)
- 2 thin magnets for the waterfall

Procedure:

1. Cut and score the cardstock to the following measurements:
 - A: 8" x 10"; score the 10" side at 3 ½" and 4".
 - B: 8" x 10 7/8"; score the 10 7/8" side at ½", 1", and 6".
 - C: 8 ¾" x 5 7/8" (2 pieces); score the 8 7/8" side at ½" and 7/8"
 - D: 8 3/8" x 5 7/8" (2 pieces); score the 8 3/8" side at ½"
 - E: 8 ¾" x 3 ½" (pocket); score the 8 ¾" at ½" and 8 ¼", rotate it and score the 3 ½" side at ½".
 - F: 6 ½" x 5 7/8"; score the 6 ½" side at ½".
 - Waterfall: 4 ¾" x 4 ¼" (5 pieces); score the 4 ¾" side at ½"
2. Apply tape to the flaps and assemble as shown in the video. Remember to leave the gaps around the waterfall area without tape.
3. Round the top corners of part A.
4. Create the pocket E by trimming the corners diagonally without touching the scoring line. Apply tape around the three scored borders. Add the pocket to C on the left side of the album. You can see the process in the video.
5. Cut the papers a slightly smaller than the area you are going to cover. I cut them ¼" smaller in height and width.
6. Before adding the waterfall to the album, cover the area with a piece of patterned paper and add the waterfall on top. Check the video to see how I made a closure for the waterfall using a ½" strip of white cardstock and magnets.
7. Embellish as you like and have fun!

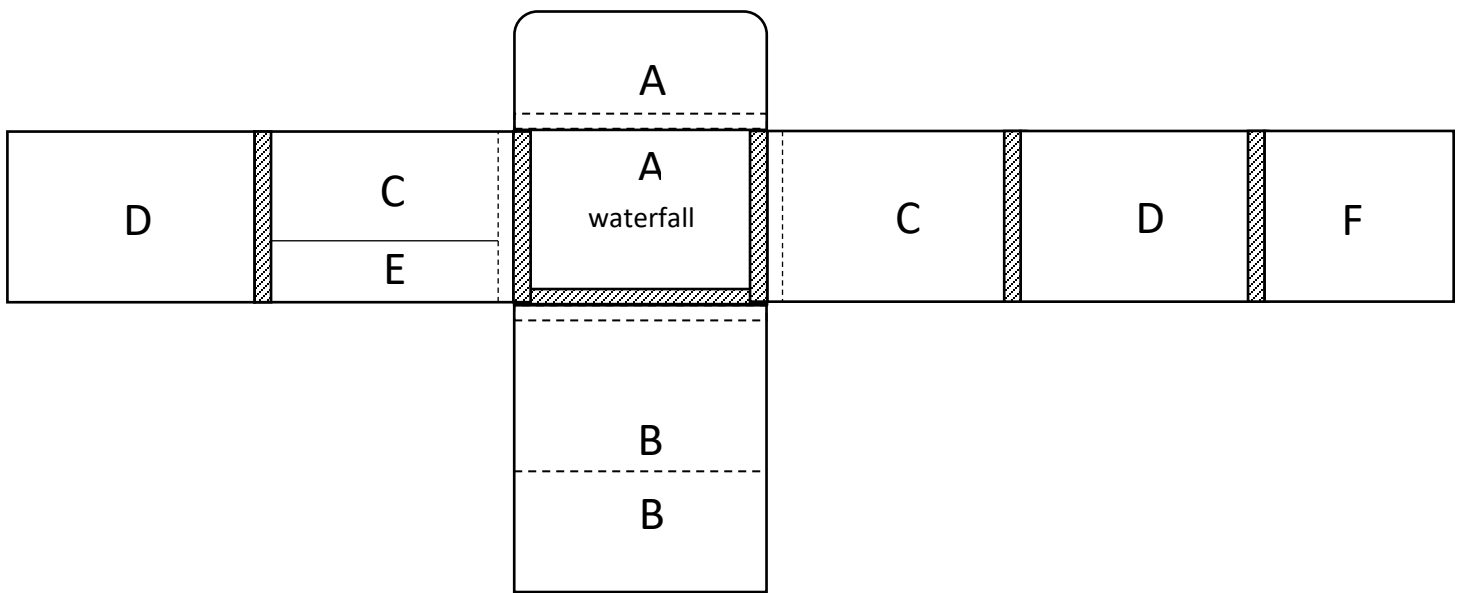


Diagram of Album When Open
